IU Goes to HU

Union Board sponsors trip to Washington D.C. for the Howard University Homecoming

BLOOMINGTON, In--This week the Indiana University Memorial Union Board Outreach Committee will take Indiana University students to Washington D.C. to experience the Washington Mall and one of the biggest Yard Fests in the country at Howard University.

The trip will take place **Thursday, Oct. 20 through Sunday, Oct. 23**. The trip is only open to the campus and costs 175.00 per person.

HU is an historical black college university that has contributed to America's political history and is known to be the birth place of five of the nine Greek letter organizations in the National Pan-Hellenic Council.
